Maria and Vice President Sonya Rosenwirth then presented an informative summary about Retirement Living vs Long-term-care. They communicated that Dom Lipa is actually 2 homes in one and that the two divisions are differentiated in their admittance criteria and admission processes. The retirement home (independent living) is private and Dom Lipa controls the waiting list. The long-term-care residence (nursing home) is government funded to make it affordable for residents and the ministry controls the admissions. Interested parties are encouraged to explore Dom Lipa by booking a tour or by arranging a meeting with the executive director, Theresa MacDermid, who can help explain the admission processes in greater detail.

We were pleased to have a bake sale with scrumptious baked goods coming from the community, Dom Lipa's staff, volunteers, residents and their families who donated hundreds of cookies, strudels, squares, potica, and many sweet treat favourites. The Dom Lipa Senior's Group worked hard all year to create beautiful craft and knitted items, a welcome addition every year with two tables of treasures.

Top performers from Dom Lipa's 2016 Walk-A-Thon were celebrated and their names will be added to trophies displayed in the Dom Lipa front lobby. We hope to see you on June 4, 2017 for the 35<sup>th</sup> annual Sunny Sonček Walk-a-thon!
